Changes to Alcohol Sales in Ontario

The Ontario government recently announced that by January 2026, consumers will be able to buy beer, wine, cider, coolers, seltzers, and other low-alcohol ready-to-

where these products can be purchased, the largest expansion of consumer choice and convenience since the end of prohibition almost 100 years ago. Spirits like vodka, gin and whisky will continue to be sold at the LCBO.

This is an exciting and long-awaited development;. However, it is too early to know the exact repercussions on our business and it is important to note that the LCBO will remain the exclusive importer and wholesaler for all retail, bars and restaurants selling alcohol.

We will continue to update you on regulatory changes in our market as they unfold.

LCBO Lab Fees

Effective April 1, 2024, the LCBO Quality Assurance Chemical Analysis standard cost per sample of wine will be increasing from \$250 to \$275.
